SOUTHERN SWING YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP

The Southern Swing Youth Championship will be open to drivers whose competition age for 2026 is between 8 and 18 for pony drivers or 10 and 18 for horse drivers. The championship will be held at the preliminary level, and competitors must have completed at least 1 competition or exhibition at the preliminary level or above within three years preceding the championship. These classes will follow all USEF rules for the preliminary level, and drive the USEF Preliminary 1 Dressage Test. All rules for marathon and cones shall apply, EXCEPT sharing of navigators, carriages, or harness is not permitted. There will be one class for pony drivers and one class for horse drivers. Awards will be presented at each event, with a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion which will be presented at the Grand Oaks Winter Season Finale, March 26 – 29, 2026. In order to determine the Grand Champion and Reserve, points will be awarded for each event as follows: 6 points for 1st place, 5 for 2nd place, 4 for 3rd place, 3 for 4th place, 2 for 5th place and 1 for 6th place. Participating events are Grand Oaks Short Format, Florida Horse Park CDE, Spring Fling at the Grand Oaks CDE, Live Oak International and Grand Oaks Winter Season Finale.

Entry Fee CDE: Beginner and Training \$300; Preliminary and Intermediate \$350; Advanced \$400

Entry Fee CT: \$150

Refund Policy: Full refund of entry fee prior to closing date, with a doctors or veterinarians note.

Refunds after closing date are at the discretion of the OC.

Stall Fee: \$275/stall, from Tues – Sunday. Stabling closes at 5 PM, Sunday. Stabling Includes does not include Sunday night.

Section A will be a Controlled Warmup, of 25 – 30 minutes, at the discretion of the TD and the Jury.

The pace in Section B is free, except for Beginner and Training who may only WALK OR TROT in Section B, including the obstacles.

VERY IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

Drivers and/or navigators may go round the marathon course a maximum of 2 times, if schedule allows, pursuant to DC Article 928.2.2 and for purposes of this event, also applies to sharing of carriage or harness. Competitors wishing to share navigators, drivers acting as navigators, carriages or harness must complete the Special Request for Sharing Form. Failure to complete the form will result in the request not being honored. This form must be turned in to the Scorer when competitor numbers are picked up at the show office.

Additional Information

Veterinary and Health Requirements: Flu and Rhino within 6 months of show date and Coggins within 1 year of show date.

Awards: Six Ribbons for each class.

Food available on grounds: Yes, on competition days. Prior to the start of the competition, competitors will be responsible for their own food.

Dog Policy: Pursuant to GR 1301. 6 Dogs are not allowed to be loose on the competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. be on a leash and under control at all times. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow Warning Card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7.

Camping on Grounds: Yes, see the Fee page.

Directions to Show Grounds: 11008 S. Highway 475, Ocala, FL 34480

Starting Order for dressage will be done by random computer draw. Marathon and Cones shall be scheduled pursuant to DC Article 932.2. Starting Order for Marathon and Cones. The athletes will go in reverse order of the results of the previous competition(s), or an order that meets the scheduling needs of the organizer.

Awards shall be presented with horses after the Cones have finished. Awards for CT shall be presented at the end of the day on Wednesday.

Sharps Container: Competition Management may fine any individuals, including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.


Motorized Vechicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) deadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.


